FROM THE CHAIRMAN

The 95th year of the 'Fed' began with changes to our team: Alison Wakelin appointed as Vice Chairman, Chris Blevins as Hon Secretary and Treasurer and Simon Radford as Youth Co-ordinator. New to the job, but bringing a wealth of harbour experience to the Fed's key roles of regulating racing in the busiest harbour in the UK, organising Chichester Harbour Race Week (CHRW) with the largest attendance of any open regatta and fulfilling our statutory requirement to provide four delegates to Chichester Harbour Conservancy Advisory Committee with two members serving on the Conservancy.

The Harbourmaster's year end report noted the harbour remained very busy for dinghy racing but of no less than 268 incidents, not one involved a racing dinghy or keelboat. This is a considerable relief, but we cannot afford the slightest complacency in ensuring our members, racing amongst the 10,000 boats registered in Chichester Harbour, adhere to the Federation's Racing Code of Conduct. This is found in this Yearbook, or downloadable as a PDF from www.chifed.org. and if you race in the harbour please read it. We enjoy far less intervention by our Harbourmaster than most other harbours and we all need to make the extra effort to preserve this.

Another success for CHRW last year replenished our funds so we are again looking for projects to support for the benefit of the whole harbour. Fed sponsorship for two series of Senior Instructor Courses at Cobnor Activities Centre was oversubscribed and we can do this again if there is demand. We also contributed to the construction of a Sea Bin at Emsworth Yacht Haven as part of our support for the CHC campaign to reduce levels of plastic in the harbour. As you look round the harbour this has been noticeably successful for larger plastic waste: for micro plastic, however, solutions are still urgently needed.

There is growing interest in rowing in the harbour, with several sailing clubs now having boats for members to row as well as the steadily gaining support for the Gig racing clubs. We expect this trend to continue and an open day at Itchenor Sailing Club in early March was very well attended despite blustery weather. As a healthy shared activity on the water, rowing has so much to commend it and there is higher level of women participants than men!

The Fed Spring General Meeting hosted Dr Richard Austin, CHC AONB Manager, who told us about his soon to be published 5 Year Plan for Chichester Harbour. This ambitious document sets out the 15 policies to be pursued to maintain and improve the AONB, many relying on the support of your Federation. The Plan is particularly important in showing how effective the management of our AONB is while we wait for the findings of the Glover Report, commissioned to look into the workings of National Parks and AONBs, which could affect all harbour users. Copies of the Plan will be free at the Harbour Office or can be read on line at www.conservancy.co.uk. Find out more about the Conservancy at their Open Day on the 27th April.

Your Federation publishes regular Newsletters. If you don't already get these, simply email [asst.secretary@chifed.org](mailto:secretary@chifed.org) to be added to our growing circulation list. Changes to our website will help improve our communications after a survey by CHC found us to be least well known of the harbour wide organisations, despite being the oldest and having the influence we do. We expect to be able to continuously update information on harbour racing, fixtures and details of activities by both our club and commercial members.

Congratulations to Emsworth Sailing Club on their centenary in 2019 and it is a tribute to the enduring appeal of sailing as a sport and the attractions of a well run club that they do so with a waiting list for membership. Congratulations also to Derek Russell, Chairman's Committee member and RYA representative to the Advisory Committee on his well deserved award of the Freedom of Chichester Harbour for his contribution to improving water quality over many years.

After that wonderful Summer last year we look forward to another busy season and I wish you safe and happy boating.

The Federation's important role in managing leisure sailing has been recognised by the Chichester Harbour Act 1971 which entitles the Federation to appoint four representatives to the Advisory Committee and two to the Conservancy. The Federation therefore plays an important role influencing every aspect of harbour policy making, including safety, regulation, finance, planning and the environment. The Chairman's Committee meets quarterly to review Conservancy papers and brief those who represent you on the various Conservancy Committees.

RACING AND FEDERATION CLUB EVENTS

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR RACING IN CHICHESTER HARBOUR

1. When scheduling races and laying courses within the Harbour, all Club Officials, Race Officers and competitors shall comply with this Code of Conduct. This code forms part of the Harbour's Port Marine Safety Code.
2. The Harbour is primarily a recreational harbour, within which the racing of sailing craft is limited to dinghies, day keel-boats and sailboards. Race Officers shall always be mindful of non-racing craft using the harbour as shall competitors who shall navigate "with care and caution and in such manner as shall not cause annoyance to the occupants of any other vessel or cause damage or danger to any other vessel or to any moorings or other property." [Harbour Byelaw 4]
3. Cruiser racing shall normally take place outside the Harbour limits. However, between 1st October and 31st March, when the weather is inclement and there will be no conflict with dinghy, day keel-boat or sailboard racing such racing may take place in the Harbour. The onus of responsibility shall lie with the Race Officer to ensure that any such cruiser racing does not conflict with dinghy/keel-boat/sailboard racing from any club, or other harbour traffic.
4. Sports boats and large 'skiff type' yachts (as currently defined in RORC rules) are treated similarly to cruisers. [see Clause 3]
5. The racing of multi-hulls is not deemed appropriate within the Harbour and no Club shall promote, sponsor or encourage this type of racing within the Harbour. The Challenger trimaran is permitted as a concession to allow sailors with disabilities to enjoy racing.
6. All sailors are reminded that when a boat sailing under the Racing Rules of Sailing meets a vessel that is not she shall comply with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (IRPCAS but often referred to as Col Regs).

Competitors should be aware that under these regulations they are obliged:

(a) to keep clear of any vessel restricted in her ability to manoeuvre or a vessel engaged in fishing, and not to impede the passage of any vessel which can safely navigate only within a narrow channel or fairway

(b) to at all times maintain a proper look-out and, if overtaking another vessel, to keep clear **and they should**

- i have due regard for slower moving vessels which may be constrained by their draught, slow response time or limited manoeuvrability, (particularly relevant to helmsmen of high speed dinghies)
- ii avoid passing too close to a non-racing vessel, failing to make their intention clear and leaving it too late for avoiding action to be taken
- iii normally pass astern of a non racing vessel, not ahead, in a close quarters situation
- iv always be courteous, acknowledging boats that have kept clear even when they are obliged to do so

7. **Race Officers** should avoid setting any course where:

(a) the starting line crosses a main fairway, especially at times of peak harbour traffic, but in any event shall always ensure that any start or finish line does not prevent non-racing traffic being able to pass safely

(b) competitors will obstruct a main fairway channel during the pre-start sequence

(c) competitors will pass through the East Head anchorage (defined by the area to the south of a line from Snowhill and East Head Spit Buoys) at those times when this venue is likely to be congested, particularly on public holiday weekends and in July and August.

Race Officers shall also take account of the increased risks to other harbour users which may arise when competitors are racing in conditions of fresh breezes and/or at either low or neap tides, where navigable water is limited, and clubs should avoid programming races for any fleet which because of its size would significantly hamper navigation in the fairways.

Incidents between vessels racing shall be dealt with by normal procedure under the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Any significant incident or accident with a wider interest for harbour safety (particularly involving a third party) should be reported to the Harbour Master.8.

8. **Race Officers:**

(a) should consult the Federation Fixture List and, if necessary, consult with other Clubs to avoid clashes between racing fleets

- (b) shall lay start lines clear of navigation or racing marks.
 - (c) shall not use navigation or Federation racing marks as one end of any start line
 - (d) shall not use navigation marks (except MILL RYTHE and ROOKWOOD) as turning marks.
9. Federation racing marks with a designated rounding direction must be rounded in the direction specified in the schedule published in the Federation Yearbook, (Federation Regatta Week excepted).
 10. The use of CHI, HARD, W-E, RIZZI and SPARKES is not formally covered by this Code. Clubs proposing to use these marks are, however, requested to forewarn HISC & CCRC with the intended date, the rounding direction and the approximate time they will be used.
 11. During winter racing, courses should be set to minimise the disturbance to wildfowl. The upper reaches of the Harbour and shorelines where wildfowl are resting should be avoided.

The boundary of Chichester Harbour for navigation purposes is defined at the harbour entrance by a line from Eastoke Buoy to the spire of West Wittering church.

Approved by The Federation Council, 22nd March 2014.

NON-PAYMENT OF HARBOUR DUES

The Federation recommends Clubs to withhold all prizes from yachts who have not paid Harbour Dues.

It is recommended that the Race team and all safety boats monitor Channel 16, in addition to their normal club channel, so they can be in a position to render assistance.

FEDERATION CONSTITUTION

1. NAME

The name shall be “The Chichester Harbour Federation”.

2. OBJECTS

The objects of the Federation are:

- (1) To promote goodwill and fellowship between members.
- (2) To organise social, cruising and racing events under the flag of the Federation.
- (3) To co-ordinate the yachting activities of members for their mutual advantage.
- (4) To agree upon the physical characteristics and positioning of racing marks within the Harbour, and to allocate club responsibility for each mark.
- (5) To represent the views of members collectively to the responsible Harbour Authority regarding:
 - (a) Navigational buoyage, marks and lighting;
 - (b) Charges and Harbour Dues;
 - (c) Bye-laws;
 - (d) The administration and preservation of the Harbour generally and the facilities provided;
 - (e) Development policies insofar as they affect yachting interests;
 - (f) Any matters not mentioned above which the Council deem to be the concern of the Federation.
 - (g) Subject to approval of the Federation Council, the Federation may affiliate to other Organisations or Associations in the interest of furthering these objects.

3. MEMBERSHIP

(1) Membership is open to organisations in the following categories:

- A. All clubs which are recognised by the Royal Yachting Association and whose headquarters are within the bounds of Chichester Harbour.
- B. All other clubs and organisations operating mainly on the waters of Chichester Harbour and based on the shores of the Harbour, whose constitution is approved by the Council.
- C. Yacht and boat building and repair yards, or combinations thereof, which are situated on the shores of Chichester Harbour and who are members of their own trade federation, or who have been in business in the Harbour for at least five years.
- D. Sailing schools and charter companies, or combinations thereof, which are based on and operating in Chichester Harbour, and which are recognised by the Royal Yachting Association and who are members of their own trade federation or have been in business in the Harbour for at least five years.

(2) Candidate organisations must be duly proposed and seconded in writing by existing members. Election to the Federation shall be the prerogative of the Council and shall be decided by a show of hands. A two-thirds majority vote from those attending shall be required to elect.

4. BUSINESS

The Business of the Federation shall be conducted by the Federation Council. The Council shall hold its Annual General Meeting during November or December. There shall also be a Spring General Meeting, at which the accounts shall be presented; and a Fixtures Meeting, at which the fixtures for the following year shall be made. An Extraordinary General Meeting shall be held at the request of at least ten members. Three weeks notice shall be given to the Honorary Secretary of the proposed date of the Extraordinary General Meeting.

5. THE FEDERATION COUNCIL

(1) COMPOSITION:

The Council shall comprise a Chairman, a Vice-Chairman, an Honorary Secretary and Treasurer, an Honorary Assistant Secretary, an Honorary Sailing Secretary and an Honorary Youth Co-ordinator, who shall be the Officers; two representatives appointed by each Category A membership; and one representative appointed by each membership in Categories B, C and D: together with the Federation representatives on the Conservancy Advisory Committee, if not otherwise included in the foregoing.

(2) ELECTION OF OFFICERS

The Election of Officers shall normally take place at the Annual General Meeting, and those elected

shall take office immediately after that meeting. Officers shall retire annually at the Annual General Meeting, but they shall be eligible for reappointment with the exception that neither the Chairman nor the Vice-Chairman shall serve in that capacity for more than six years.

(3) **APPOINTMENT OF COUNCIL MEMBERS:**

All Council members shall retire annually at the Annual General Meeting, except that Advisory Committee members shall retire after the term laid down in the Conservancy Act. All council members shall be eligible for re-election.

(4) **VOTING POWER:**

Members of the Council shall have one vote each, except where only one member representing a Category A Club is present he shall have two votes. In the event of a tie the Chairman of the meeting shall have a second, casting vote. Any member organisation which is more than six months in arrears with its subscription shall not be entitled to vote until such arrears have been paid.

6. **CHAIRMAN'S COMMITTEE**

There shall be a Chairman's Committee comprised of the Officers of the Federation and such other members as shall be appointed by the Council from its members, so that the total membership of the Committee shall not be less than ten. The Committee membership shall be appointed at the Annual General Meeting. The Chairman's Committee shall be empowered to carry out the Council's business within the framework of general policies upon which the Council may from time to time decide. The Chairman's Committee shall have power to co-opt members to fill any vacancies occurring during the year.

7. **REGATTA COMMITTEE**

There shall be a Regatta Committee empowered to organise and run the annual Chichester Harbour Federation Regatta Week. The Regatta Committee shall comprise the Chairman and Honorary Sailing Secretary of the Federation, together with the Race Officers of the Regatta and such other members as may be appointed by the Council from the Federation Sailing Clubs. The total membership of the Regatta Committee shall not be less than ten, and such that no one Sailing Club's representatives shall be able to have a voting majority on the Committee.

The committee members shall be appointed by the Council at the Fixtures Meeting and the Regatta Committee shall have the power to co-opt members to fill any vacancies occurring during the year.

The Honorary Sailing Secretary shall submit an income and expenditure account after each Regatta to the Honorary Secretary and Treasurer. Regatta monies shall be noted separately and an appropriate cash reserve shall be carried forward each year, clearly identified in the accounts and based upon recommendation of the Regatta Committee as to amount, available to underwrite non recoverable costs in the event of the Regatta not being able to take place or being restricted in the following year.

8. **CHICHESTER HARBOUR CONSERVANCY ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

The Federation is represented by four members on the Advisory Committee. These shall be appointed by nomination and election by the Council. Nominees must belong to a member organisation of the Federation.

9. **SUBSCRIPTIONS**

The subscription rates shall be determined by the Council. Subscriptions for the current year shall fall due on 1st April.

10. **ARREARS OF SUBSCRIPTION**

The Hon. Secretary shall inform the Council at the Annual General Meeting of all member organisations in arrears with subscriptions. Any member organisation which is more than six months in arrears with its subscription shall not be entitled either to propose any resolution or to vote at Council meetings until such arrears have been paid. If the arrears remain unpaid, such membership may be terminated at the discretion of the Chairman's Committee.

11. **FINANCE**

The Accounts of the Federation shall be kept by the Hon. Secretary and Treasurer who shall produce an audited balance sheet for the past calendar year at the Spring General Meeting of the Council.

12. **AUDITOR**

The Council shall appoint an Honorary Auditor annually at the Annual General Meeting.

13. **AMENDMENT OF THE CONSTITUTION**

The Constitution may be amended, after due notice in writing has been given, by the Council. Any proposed amendments shall normally be put to the Annual General Meetings but may go before an appropriately convened Extraordinary General Meeting or Spring General Meeting. For approval the amendment shall require a two thirds majority vote of those present.
